Residential Burglary

Toms hill Road - the victims house alarm has been activated, which has woken the occupants up. The victim has looked out the rear window to see unknown suspects breaking into his shed in the rear of the garden. The shed has an alarm fitted, which is connected to the main house. The is activated when people step inside the shed, the victim has run out, however suspects had left

Criminal Damage

Stocks Road - offenders have slashed a tyre, while the vehicle was parked on the victim's drive.

Stoneycroft - the rear driver's side window has been smashed by unknown means; nothing appears to have been taken from the vehicle.
